COUNT ONE

(Involuntary Manslaughter)

On or about October 10, 2011, upon the high seas and within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the defendant,

**ALICIA KEIR,**

did kill infant Keir, without malice, while engaged in a lawful act and while acting without due caution and circumspection, which she knew and reasonably should have known was a threat to human life, that is, by giving birth to infant Keir while onboard a cruise ship and not summoning help or seeking medical attention.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1112(a) and 7.
